Low back pain - a major global health challenge

On 21 March 2018 the Lancet published a series of three papers highlighting the fact that low back pain is the number one cause of disability worldwide and continues to rise with the ageing and increasing world population (freely available at www.thelancet.com/series/low-back-pain). Millions of people across the world, including low-income and middle-income countries are receiving low value care.

Written by 31 leading international back pain experts from 13 countries, the first paper presents the latest information about the epidemiology of the condition, its personal and societal burden as well as the factors that contribute to persisting disabling low back pain. The second paper discusses the latest evidence about the prevention and treatment of low back pain as well as the global gap between evidence and practice with numerous examples from both high-income as well as low- and middle-income countries. It also presents promising and/or emerging solutions, many of which need further evaluation before large-scale implementation could be considered. The final paper in the series is a call for global organizations such as the WHO and international and national leaders to take action to reduce the increasing and costly effects of disabling low back pain. Within 24 hours the series generated 13.5 million impressions on twitter and was covered by an extensive range of media worldwide. Prof. Buchbinder's talk will describe the series and what the experts hope it achieves.

Prof. Rachelle Buchbinder is a rheumatologist and clinical epidemiologist funded by an Australian NHMRC Senior Principal Research Fellowship. She is the Director of the Monash Department of Clinical Epidemiology, Cabrini Institute; Professor in the Department of Epidemiology and Preventive Medicine, Monash University; Joint Coordinating Editor of the Cochrane Musculoskeletal Group; and current President of the Australian Rheumatology Association. She is a founding member and current Steering Group Chair of the NHMRC Centre of Research Excellence for the recently established Australia & New Zealand Musculoskeletal (ANZMUSC) Clinical Trial Network. Prof. Buchbinder combines clinical practice with research in a wide range of multidisciplinary projects relating to arthritis and musculoskeletal conditions. She has a longstanding commitment to knowledge synthesis and implementation of clinical research evidence to guide clinical decision-making and improve patient outcomes. Her current program of work concerns reducing inappropriate or low value care. She was a lead author and chaired the steering group for The Lancet Low Back Pain Series published in March 2018.
